EULab Roundtable on Labour Migration

The role of local authorities in the social integration process
of labour migrants, with particular reference to agricultural,
domestic and care workers

Thursday, 15 July 2021

The EULab Roundtable offers to many different actors a rare and valuable occasion of engaging in a fruitful discussion concerning the role of local authorities in the social integration process of labour migrants, with specific attention to those working in the agricultural, domestic and care sectors. For this reason, this exchange of ideas will take place in an open setting. The dialogue between international and EU scholars, policy makers and practitioners will be open to the general public, raising issues of great importance for civil society at large.

Thanks to this interactive and comprehensive dialogue, participants to the EULab Summer School and other attendees will learn about the practical impact of legislative and policy choices of local authorities on the actual enjoyment of migrant workers' rights, a topic intimately connected to the degree of social integration of labour migrants.

Besides the **30 participants to the Summer School, 15 additional attendees** (policy makers, lawyers, NGOs workers and representatives of migrant workers' communities) will contribute to the Roundtable. The event will be **open to the general public**.

In the days preceding the event (and by 1 July at the latest), each participant will be invited to **submit a short abstract (max 500 words) or bullet points of their intervention**, which should concern the topic of labour migrants' social integration. Drafts on aspects related to the specific situation of migrant workers in the agricultural, domestic and care sectors are particularly welcome.

Following a general introduction by the Chair of the EULab Roundtable, each participant will be allocated **10 minutes** to express their point of view, in order to allow every attendee to intervene and encourage a follow-up dialogue between them as well as with the general public.
